Zunder opens its 200th charging station in Madrid with the support of the City Council and the presence of Borja Carabante



- Zunder's 200th charging station is located in Ensanche de Vallecas and features 16 ultra-rapid charging points with capacities of up to 400 kW. The rest of the company's operational stations are distributed across Spain, France and Portugal.
- The event was attended by Borja Carabante, Madrid City Council's Delegate for Urban Planning, Environment and Mobility; Luis Miguel Torres, Director General for Transport and Mobility of the Community of Madrid; and Daniel Pérez, CEO and co-founder of Zunder.
- Zunder currently operates over 80 ultra-rapid charging points across the Community of Madrid and aims to reach 200 connectors in the coming months.

Zunder, the leading ultra-rapid EV charging operator in Southern Europe, today inaugurated its 200th station in Madrid, located in Ensanche de Vallecas. The event was marked by the presence of senior institutional representatives, including Borja Carabante, Delegate for Urban Planning, Environment and Mobility of Madrid City Council; Luis Miguel Torres, Director General for Transport and Mobility of the Community of Madrid; and Daniel Pérez, CEO and co-founder of Zunder.

The new ultra-rapid charging station in Ensanche de Vallecas—Zunder's 200th to date—is strategically located next to the M-40 motorway (exits 19B and 20), ensuring convenient access from both directions. It forms part of Zunder's ambitious expansion across the Community of Madrid, particularly

within the capital, where the company already operates over 80 ultra-rapid charging points currently in use.

During the inauguration, Borja Carabante stated: "We want Madrid to be the capital of sustainable mobility and electromobility, and we are working on every front to make it happen—public-private partnerships, incentives, regulation, infrastructure... and above all, commitment. Thanks to the vision of people like Daniel Pérez, CEO of Zunder, who understood that electric mobility is not just an economic activity but a commitment to our cities, electromobility is now an unstoppable reality in Spain."

Daniel Pérez added: "Reaching station number 200 in a city like Madrid is no coincidence. The capital is a key driver of electric mobility in Spain and a hub for our international investors. Zunder is committed to leading this transformation by offering powerful, accessible charging stations and a seamless user experience. At the same time, this rollout is boosting local employment, generating over 50 direct and 1,000 indirect jobs in the region."

The Zunder Ensanche de Vallecas station is an ultra-rapid charging HUB offering 16 spacious bays equipped with CCS connectors capable of delivering up to 400 kW. All chargers are compatible with Plug&Charge technology, enabling automatic charging as soon as the vehicle is plugged in—no app or card required. This feature is especially useful for fleet operations such as ride-hailing services (VTC). Users can also pay via card using the integrated terminal or through RFID systems such as the eZCard or eZTag key fob.

Zunder is not only expanding its charging footprint—it is building a fast, reliable and ultra-rapid network that positions Madrid as one of Europe's leading electric mobility hubs. The company currently has 12 additional projects underway in key municipalities such as Alcalá de Henares, Collado Villalba, Alcorcón, Pinto and Las Rozas. Its objective is to reach 200 operational charging points in the region in the coming months, with a total investment of nearly €30 million.

In addition to deploying ultra-rapid charging stations across Madrid, Zunder has also gained the trust of public institutions, such as the Las Rozas City Council, to oversee its charging network through Zunder's SaaS platform for charging point management and monitoring.

La compañía ofrece servicios 360 a la movilidad eléctrica, con más de 1.000 puntos de carga operativos en España, Francia y Portugal; estaciones específicas para camiones eléctricos y software de gestión de cargadores. Gracias al acuerdo de financiación con el Banco Santander, con 225 millones, Zunder consolida su expansión internacional de apertura de infraestructuras de carga.
