## Zunder, Uber and AURO sign an strategic agreement to promote electric mobility in major cities



- The agreement will drive the electrification plans of Auro Group's VTC fleet, a strategic partner of Uber, by providing EV charging solutions.
- The initial phase of the partnership includes a Zunder–Auro collaboration at the Vicálvaro station in Madrid, located next to Auro's headquarters, with 10 ultrafast charging points exclusive to Uber vehicles, offering up to 400 kW of power.
- Zunder continues to expand its ultrafast charging network in Madrid, with new stations in Vicálvaro, the Transport Centre (CTM), and soon in Ensanche de Vallecas, providing both users and businesses with powerful, accessible infrastructure.
- This collaboration strengthens the commitment to reducing emissions in Madrid by offering practical solutions for users who seek to travel more sustainably.

Zunder, a leading operator of ultrafast electric vehicle charging in Europe; Auro Group, Spain's largest chauffeur-driven vehicle company specializing in passenger transport management and a strategic partner of Uber; and Uber, the global mobility app and platform, have signed an agreement to promote sustainable mobility. As part of this effort, dedicated ultrafast charging bays will be made available at Zunder stations for Auro–Uber vehicles.

Major cities are increasingly focused on implementing solutions that promote efficient, sustainable, and safe mobility—key to decarbonization and improving air quality, as seen in Madrid. In this context, chauffeur-driven vehicle companies like Auro Group are incorporating more electric vehicles into their fleets, lowering air and noise pollution and offering greater comfort to

passengers, who are increasingly demanding sustainable mobility options.

To support this transition, ultrafast charging stations are essential—they must provide rapid, safe, efficient, and reliable charging, capable of handling peak demand and enabling dozens of vehicles to charge simultaneously. In this regard, Auro Group and Uber have chosen Zunder as their charging partner in Madrid for this initial phase, with plans to scale infrastructure further.

The first station included in the agreement is Zunder's site at Calle Dehesa Vieja 74 in the Vicálvaro district of Madrid, strategically located near the M-45 and adjacent to Auro Group's headquarters. The facility includes 16 Alpitronic CCS charging points offering up to 400 kW of power—able to charge a vehicle to 80% in under 20 minutes, depending on the model. To optimize charging times and enhance service performance, 10 of the 16 charging points are exclusively reserved for Auro Group's Uber fleet and clearly marked. The remaining six are available for general public use.

**Daniel Pérez, CEO and Co-Founder of Zunder, stated:** “Signing this agreement with Auro Group, Uber's strategic partner, represents recognition and trust from Spain's leading chauffeur-driven vehicle company and the world's top mobility platform. Their commitment to Zunder is based on the reliability of our stations, our 24/7 customer service, and the ease of charging with maximum power. Zunder adapts its solutions to companies' needs, and the trust placed in us by thousands of users who charge daily at our stations has helped us become Spain's top-rated charging operator. That's why we will continue to deliver the same quality and service commitment.”

**Luis Miguel Torres, Director General of Transport and Mobility for the Madrid Region, added:** “We welcome this new ultrafast charging station in Vicálvaro as a key milestone in the transition to more efficient mobility. The Madrid Region strongly supports the expansion of charging infrastructure, which is crucial to accelerate the electrification of transport and reduce fossil fuel dependency. Achieving this goal requires a solid, accessible, and powerful network—like the one unveiled here today. We must simplify administrative procedures and support projects like this one, which blend technology, efficiency, and environmental responsibility. We will keep working to ensure Madrid leads in clean mobility and energy self-sufficiency in Spain.”

The station offers several user benefits, including accessible bays for people with reduced mobility and convenient charging through advanced Plug&Charge technology (particularly relevant for Auro's fleet), as well as multiple payment options via the Zunder app, card payment terminals, or Zunder's eZCard.
