This vision enabled it to evolve from a software solution into a leader in ultra-rapid charging infrastructure in Spain and Southern Europe. This evolution has been key to establishing Zunder as a benchmark in the electric mobility sector. Today, Zunder is a leading reference in ultra-rapid charging and is on track to become the market leader across Europe.

Zunder is the leading ultra-rapid charging operator in Spain and is undergoing international expansion, with proprietary charging stations in Spain, France, and Portugal — and plans to grow into new European markets. Currently, we have more than 200 stations in operation and over 1,200 active charging points.

## 1. History & Growth

What began as a YouTube channel soon became a mission: to make EV charging more accessible and user-friendly. Since the start, Daniel Pérez has been a visionary in the field of electric mobility. Acknowledging the challenges around the lack of fast chargers and the complexity of charging processes, he founded EasyCharger with the goal of making electric mobility more practical and approachable. His focus on simplicity and ease of use has positioned Zunder as the go-to operator for ultra-rapid EV charging in Spain and Southern Europe.

In addition to being a charging operator, we have developed our own management platform, which allows us to oversee thousands of charging points — both our own and third-party. This has enabled us not only to manage our network but also to expand our international footprint and consolidate our presence as a global player operating across multiple continents.

We are at the forefront of technology, with innovations such as card payment terminals (POS) at our stations, and the ability to initiate charging via Apple Watch, Apple CarPlay, and Android Auto. With the Zunder app, users can travel across Spain and Europe hassle-free, charging on major networks without the need to download additional apps.

### 2. Mission & Purpose

At Zunder, we are committed to the planet, people, and electric mobility. We are building the largest ultra-rapid charging network in Southern Europe — empowering EV drivers with freedom in a sustainable and environmentally respectful way. Our mission is to provide freedom and convenience to electric vehicle users through a fast-charging network powered by 100% renewable energy. We strive to meet EV users' charging needs throughout Europe quickly, efficiently, and sustainably.

4. Investment, Financing and Grants

Zunder is committed to continuing the rollout of ultra-fast charging stations, consolidating our leadership in the sector. This effort not only strengthens our market presence, but also actively supports the transition to more sustainable electric mobility—contributing to a cleaner, more efficient energy future.

We are fortunate to have investors who strongly believe in our project and share our long-term vision. Since 2021, White Summit Capital (WSC) and Global Monogram have been part of our shareholder base, with Mirova—an affiliate of Natixis Investment Managers—joining in 2022. More recently, we secured a €225 million green loan from Banco Santander, which will allow us to further accelerate our growth and reinforce our leadership in the electric mobility sector.

### 5. Infrastructure and Operations

Zunder leads the way with an ultra-fast charging network that stands out for its capacity and coverage across Europe. We operate over 1.200 strategically located charging points and more than 200 stations in Southern Europe, all designed to minimise charging times.

In France, we operate 12 ultra-fast charging stations, including one of the largest on the Auto-Route network in Les Landes, featuring 26 charging points of 400 kW, enabling extremely fast charging for the most demanding users.

In **Portugal**, our expansion continues with over 10 locations under development and the first operational ultra-fast charging station since 2023, offering drivers the ability to recharge in minutes, not hours.

Our stations are not only numerous—they are designed to deliver a seamless ultra-fast charging experience that accommodates a wide variety of electric vehicles, including heavy-duty transport. Whether for trucks, buses or camper vans, our facilities are built to maximise charging speed and significantly reduce time spent at the station.

At Zunder, we're not just building charging stations—we're redefining the ultra-fast charging experience in Europe. Through advanced technologies such as off-grid batteries and photovoltaic structures, we're not just anticipating the future of e-mobility—we're setting new standards that make that future a tangible reality.

## 7. Technology and Sustainability

Zunder uses 100% renewable energy at all its stations and has implemented advanced technologies to reduce environmental impact.

Our internally developed SaaS platform enables remote management and monitoring of charging points, offering features such as real-time monitoring, charger visibility, tariff management, and 24/7 customer support.

- Roaming: Zunder supports roaming to allow users to charge across multiple operator networks using a single app. We collaborate with platforms like Gireve and Hubject, and have roaming agreements with EDP, Galp, Naturgy, Digital Charging Solutions, Plugsurfing, and Has-to-be.
- SaaS Platform: Zunder's proprietary platform manages both our own network and third-party chargers. The software enables real-time status monitoring, visibility in our app, and full data access for operators and users.

# 9. What Makes Zunder Unique?

- Zunder App: An intuitive mobile app that allows users to charge easily across Spain, France, and Portugal—and across Europe via roaming.
- Plug&Charge / AutoCharge: A system that eliminates the need for manual authentication, enabling hassle-free charging by simply plugging in. Users can also initiate and pay for charging via Apple Watch and Android Auto.
- POS Payments (TPV): Zunder pioneered credit/debit card payment via POS terminals— offering secure, contactless payments at our stations.
- **RFID Key Fob:** An optional key fob linked to your Zunder account that enables charging without using your phone. Simply tap it on the charger's reader to start and end the session.

- eZCard: Zunder's RFID-enabled eZCard simplifies EV charging with a tap-and-go system, no app required. Users receive SMS notifications for every transaction, adding an extra layer of security and control. It enables access to thousands of charging points across multiple networks, fleet management, cost tracking, exclusive discounts, and advanced data protection.
- Monthly Subscription: A flexible €9.99 monthly plan with no commitment, offering a convenient and affordable option for regular EV users.
- Photovoltaic Canopies: Our charging canopies harness 100% renewable energy, reinforcing Zunder's commitment to sustainability and environmental protection.
- Wide Charging Bays: Zunder stations are designed to accommodate not only light electric vehicles, but also electrified heavy-duty transport—with spacious bays to facilitate easy and comfortable charging.
